
TSC Fall Expedition Trip 2026: Tanzania Safari

Drive to Serengeti National Park

You'll enjoy the safari experience of a lifetime on your guided game drive through Serengeti National Park. A guide will help you look for big cats, elephants and more as you drive through so many classic safari landscapes. Although every big cat sighting is special, they're only a part of the story here: there's a good chance you'll also see elephants, zebras, giraffes, wildebeest, buffaloes and spotted hyenas and much more.

Drive to Ngorongoro Conservation Area

Crater tour, Ngorongoro Crater. Your first sight of Ngorongoro Crater is likely not one you'll easily forget. As seen from the crater rim, this natural bowl, both vast and intimate, is one of Africa's most beautiful natural features, stretching 19 green kilometers (12 miles) from one side to the other. Return to **Ngorongoro Farm Lodge** as you pass back through Karatu.

Dive to Arusha

Day 9, Mon, Nov 9

It is departure time. (The Turkish Air flight to Houston would require leaving the hotel about midnight on Nov 8.)

Included: Domestic air, 3 nights' lodging, airport transfers, all meals. Not included: Mandatory health travel insurance of \$45 per person.

Lodging: Blue Bay Hotel or Royal Zanzibar Beach Resort

The name Zanzibar evokes images of palm-fringed coastlines framing white sandy beaches and the warm, crystal-clear water of the Indian Ocean. It's no surprise, then, that the sultans of yesteryear chose this location as their key trading post. Fly from Kilimanjaro to Zanzibar. Note: return flight departs from Zanzibar to Houston.
